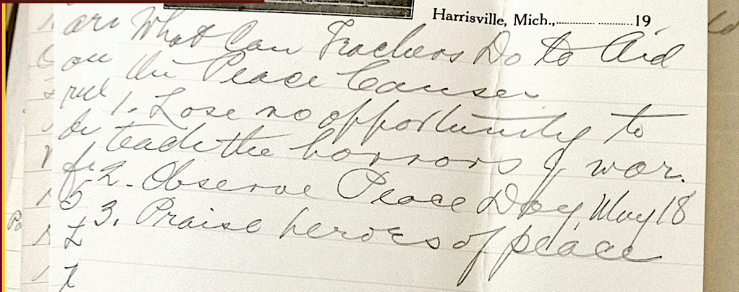
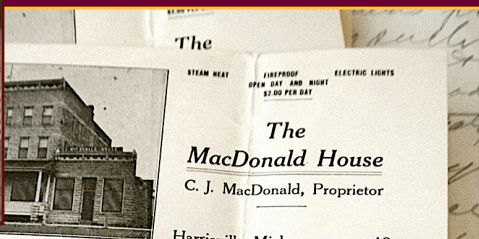

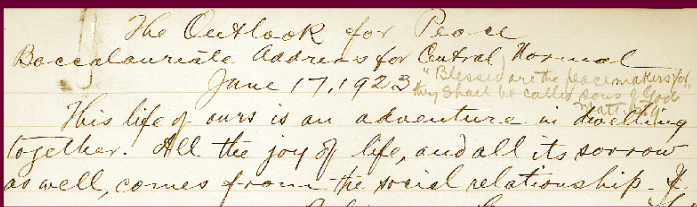
E.C. Warriner (1866-1945)
